Non-native English speakers are required to demonstrate that they have reached the high intermediate level in English language skills, with certification or other evidence equivalent to the following minimum overall TOEFL scores: Paper Based Test 550+, Computer Based Test 213+, or Internet Based Test 80+.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

- Students will automatically be enrolled in their alternative course/section, if any of their first choices is unavailable (cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or full). The Registrar reserves the right to move students to a different section in order to balance course enrollment.
- Students who enroll in Italian language courses must select a course that fits their schedule.
- Students registering for an intermediate or advanced course, including Italian language, must choose the appropriate level by carefully checking the LdM Academic Catalogue and Course Schedule (available online) for prerequisites. At LdM, these students will take a placement test to confirm their level.
- Students may attend only the courses listed on their Official Registration form. Auditing is not allowed.
- Only one class can be changed upon arrival at LdM, depending on course availability. This is only allowed during Final Registration day. Final Registration deadlines will be announced during Orientation. No exceptions will be made to these deadlines.
- If students drop any courses upon arrival, they will not be entitled to a refund.
- Mid-term and final exams will be given only on the scheduled days that appear on each course syllabus. For no reason (i.e. religious issues, travel plans, family matters, etc.) will they be moved. Exams are scheduled during normal class times, so more than one exam may be administered on the same day.
- LdM does not offer Pass/Fail grades or Incompletes, only letter grades. All classes registered for and grades received will appear on each student's Certificate of Academic Performance notwithstanding their intent to transfer credits to their home institution.
- Students with learning disabilities will be subject to local educational standards, and therefore will not be provided with the same special treatment offered by their home school. However, based on current and official documentation of the disability, LdM offers reasonable assistance to these students. It is each student's responsibility to provide this documentation within the deadline.
- LdM reserves the right to withhold the Certificate of Academic Performance and/or housing deposit of students who violate contract agreements related to housing and/or academic issues (i.e. any balance or debt incurred) and/or whose behavior is considered detrimental towards the school and other students.
- Each student must carefully read the Lorenzo de' Medici Rules of Conduct as they are different from those applied at students' home college or university. A copy of the Rules of Conduct must be signed by every student during Orientation.
- Attendance is mandatory for all courses.

PAYMENT

If a student visa is required, LdM is obligated to receive the **full balance of tuition** before releasing an official "Letter of Acceptance," which is one of the required documents for the student visa application.

If a student visa is not required, a deposit of 30% of the total tuition is due with the application, the remaining balance of the tuition is due 30 days prior to the start of the term.

Lab fees, course materials and field trips are not included in the tuition costs.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If an official cancellation notice is received by LdM:

- 20 days or more before the start of the term, the student will be liable for 10% of the tuition.
- 19 to 7 days before the start of the term, the student will be liable for 20% of the tuition.
- 6 days to the beginning of the term, no refund will be given.

After classes start, no refund will be due to students who do not attend or who withdraw from LdM.

Fees are not transferable to other persons.

Students will receive the refund minus the cost of any transfer fees.
